FAQ

How much does it cost?

It's free to open a shop. Each item you list costs \$0.20 USD for four months. Once an item sells, Etsy's fees are 3.5 percent in addition to payment processing fees, which vary, based on the payment method you chose. Etsy's direct checkout payment method fees vary slightly by location.

Do I need to register as a business?

Etsy doesn't require you to have a business license to open a shop on the site. We do ask that you follow your local laws regarding having a small business online.

What can you sell?

Etsy is a marketplace for handmade goods, vintage items and craft supplies.

Handmade refers to items that are made by you, the shop owner, or are designed by you and made with the help of an approved outside manufacturer who complies with Etsy's ethical manufacturing policies. Read Etsy's full Handmade Policy here.

Vintage items for sale on Etsy must be at least 20 years old to qualify as vintage.

Craft supplies are tools, ingredients, or materials intended for use in the creation of a new handmade item. Commercially-made materials that are ready to use as finished goods may not be sold as craft supplies on Etsy.
